The school system

Early Childhood (Kindergarten):

Early Childhood Education centres are community based, staffed by teachers possessing a certificate in teaching or personnel who have field based training.

Primary:

Currently formal education commences in primary schools at the preparatory grade. The purpose of Primary education is to introduce children to the skills needed for writing, reading, mathematics, community studies, science, agriculture, art, music, physical education and Christian education. Primary education is not compulsory, although successive governments desire that all children in the Solomon Islands attend primary education. A child is expected to commence at the age six or seven and continue for six years.

Secondary:

Secondary education follows primary schooling and continues for three (to Form 3), six (to Form 6) or for a small number, seven years (to Form 7). Students are admitted to Form 1 on the basis of their performance in the *SI Secondary School Entrance Examination*. The purpose of secondary education is to expand knowledge of subjects already studied at primary school including literature, science, mathematics, social studies, commerce and other subjects essential for physical and intellectual development and to prepare students for specialised skill training.

There are three types of secondary schools. National Secondary Schools (NSS) and Provincial Secondary Schools (PSS) are boarding schools, while Community High Schools are day schools with some limited boarding. All secondary students follow the same curriculum and sit the Form 3 Examination.

PSSs were established in the 1980s to expand the number of junior secondary school places and emphasized the need for acquiring practical subjects. They have since expanded to offer Forms 4 and 5. In many cases the facilities available, such as libraries, science laboratories and dormitories have not been expanded.

CHS were established in the early 1990's. There has been a rapid growth in the number of CHSs, in response to community support and pressure, which has strained the capacity of governments to provide trained teachers, equipment and curriculum support materials. Most do not possess buildings required to teach all subjects, especially science, or libraries.

Annual School Census

Every year the Ministry of Education and Human Resources Development (MEHRD) conducts a census of Solomon Islands Schools. The data gathered through this process is used to support planning, budgeting and policy making for the Education Sector. The survey forms completed by schools provide details about the students, teachers, facilities and infrastructure at those schools. This data is stored and analysed using the Solomon Islands Education Management Information System (SIEMIS).




