#### **Introductory Notes**

1. Collating and compiling accurate educational statistics in Papua New Guinea is yet to be systematized. The major impediments to this exercise are:
  - 1.1 The instruments (Data Forms) used by individual institutions for collecting data are not standardised, and may require to be made simple for respondents to understand and fill in with the necessary data being requested.
  - 1.2 Figures supplied by schools are the number of students whose names appear in the register which is not necessarily the same as the number attending classes. These figures may be deliberately inflated for reasons beyond the bounds of this booklet. In other cases students may have dropped out, but names could still be in the school register.
  - 1.3 Institutions failing to submit data to their respective Provincial Division of Education Office or to the National Department of Education has been a significant problem this year.
  - 1.4 The main source for the enrolment and staffing figures in this booklet is the June (Quarter 2) return as submitted by the institutions and the Provincial Education Offices. However, where such data is not available, returns for earlier months are used and even the third and fourth Quarter figures are used where necessary.
  - 1.5 Data sent in by schools and colleges are sorted out at two or more levels before collation in the current format. In this sorting and sifting process, there are chances of making errors.
2. The information in this volume relates to the data at the National or the Unified System and the Permitted schools run by the Seventh Day Adventist (SDA), and the International Education Agency (IEA) which are outside the National Education System.
3. The National Education System covers the State run schools and schools managed by Church agencies namely: the Anglican, Catholic, Lutheran, United and Evangelical Alliance. "Other agency" refers to schools run by smaller church groups like the Lutheran Gut, AOG,

Nius and the KWATO church of the United Church etc.

4. The Corporate Data Branch collates the enrolment data based on returns submitted by the Provincial Division of Education, schools and colleges to respective Divisions at the National Department of

Education. Figures on SDA and IEA schools are obtained directly from their head offices.

5. Often officers of the Corporate Data Branch and the General Education Services Division must get in direct contact with schools to collect figures or to verify them.
6. Figure 1 (page 6) shows the structure of the Papua New Guinea's Education System and indicates the levels and terminal points.
7. The tables in this bulletin had been rearranged compared to previous years and new tables included to give the user more specific information.
8. The tables are divided into sections dealing with specific education levels.
  - Tables 1 - 4 indicate the enrolment and staffing summary in all Institutions and Agencies.
  - Tables 5 - 15 provide the Elementary enrolment and staffing statistics.
  - Tables 16 - 31 shows the enrolment and staffing summary for the Primary Education.
  - Tables 32 - 44 relate to enrolment and staffing in the Secondary Education.
  - Tables 45 - 51 shows the enrolment and staffing in the Technical Colleges.
  - Tables 52 - 58 relate to enrolment and staffing in the Vocational

Centres.

- Tables 59 - 61 indicate the enrolment and staffing in the Primary Teachers colleges and University of Goroka.
  - Tables 62 - 77 relate to enrolment and staffing in the College of Distance Education.
9. All NES, SDA and IEA institutions covered here are related to the General Education Sector. The University of Goroka, which is included because of the Department of Education's interest in the number of secondary teachers trained by the University.
  10. The tables here do not include enrolments under National Training Council institutions, which if included would increase the enrolment.
  11. District Status figures for Kiunga Lake Murray should be part of Western Province in any Provincial data analysis.
  12. Analyzed data form on this edition can be obtained from the Corporate Data Branch, Department of Education, P.O. Box 446, Waigani, Papua New Guinea.


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STRUCTURE OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA EDUCATION SYSTEM
